SUBJECT: NRC APPROVAL FOR HONEYWELL INTERNATIONAL, INC. REQUEST FOR WITHHOLDING INFORMATION FROM PUBLIC DISCLOSURE

Dear Ms. Ketchum:

Honeywell International, Inc. submitted an affidavit dated June 25, 2014, executed by Kurt A. Luther, requesting that the information contained in Attachments A and B of the License Renewal Application dated May 22, 2014, be withheld from public disclosure pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR), Part 2, Section 2.390.

The affidavit stated that per §2.390, Honeywell International, Inc. is requesting the information be withheld from public disclosure for the following reasons: (1) this information is owned and is of a type customarily held in confidence by Honeywell and is not routinely disclosed to the public. Honeywell considers all information that results from its investment of time and resources to design, develop, test, and manufacture products and that is not readily apparent from the operation of the product or otherwise made available to the public as confidential and proprietary information; (2) public disclosure of this information is likely to cause substantial harm to the competitive position of Honeywell. This information is related to the design, operation, and manufacturing of Honeywell's gas plasma displays and the continued use of this information provides Honeywell with a competitive economic advantage in its marketplace. Making this information available to Honeywell's competitors may enable them to modify their manufacturing processes and product designs to better compete with Honeywell. With open access to this information, Honeywell's competitors may be about to make changes to their processes and design to better compete with Honeywell without making a similar investment of time and resources to independently develop this information.

We have reviewed your application and the material in accordance with the requirements of 10 CFR 2.390 and, on the basis of your statements, have determined that the submitted information sought to be withheld contains proprietary commercial information and should be withheld from public disclosure.
