Gentlemen:

On June 28, 1989, the NRC issued Generic Letter (GL) No. 89-10, "Safety-Related Motor-Operated Valve Testing and Surveillance," which expanded the scope of the previously issued NRC Bulletin 85-03, dated November 15, 1985, and Supplement 1 of NRC Bulletin 85-03, dated April 27, 1988. The GL 89-10 recommended that licensees' programs with respect to Motor Operated Valves (MOVs) should provide for testing, inspection, and maintenance of MOVs to provide the necessary assurance that they will function as required when subjected to both normal operation and abnormal events within the design basis of the plant. The GL 89-10 also requires licensees to notify the NRC in writing within 30 days after the actions described in GL 89-10 have been completed.

Carolina Power & Light (CP&L) Company responded to the GL 89-10 on December 27, 1989, describing our MOV program. CP&L supplemented our original response by letter dated June 6, 1991, that provided additional clarifications regarding CP&L's MOV program. The purpose of this letter is to notify the NRC that the H. B. Robinson Steam Electric Plant (HBRSEP), Unit No. 2 has completed implementation of the MOV program (i.e., GL 89-10 items a through h) in accordance with the commitments provided in CP&L's response letters dated December 27, 1990 and June 6, 1991.
