
SUBJECT: MEETING SUMMARY - ROBINSON

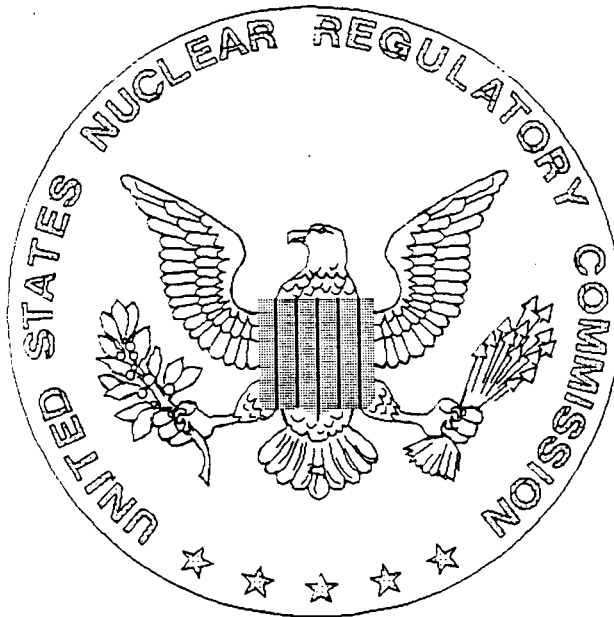

ROBINSON NUCLEAR PLANT

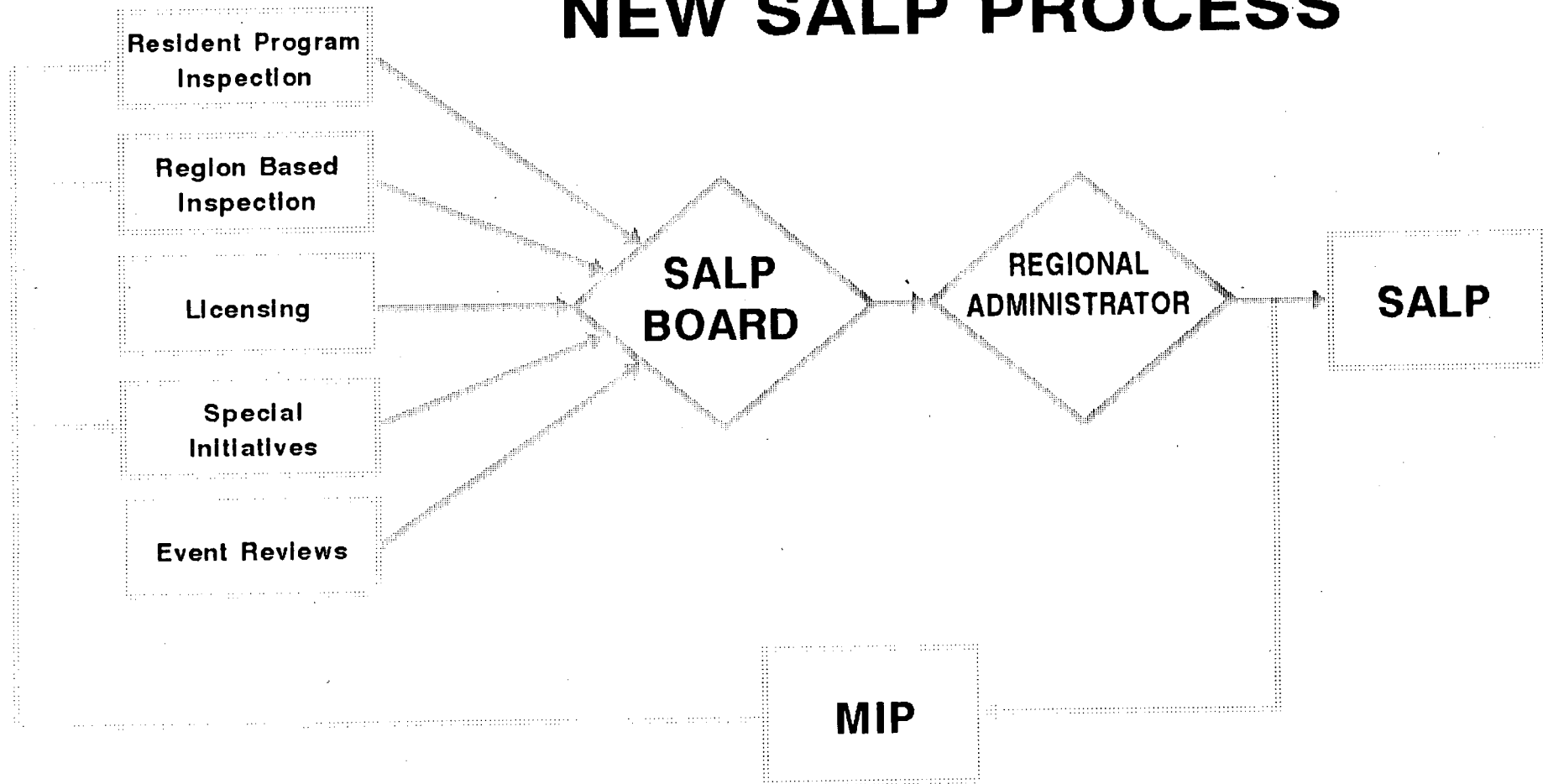
