In a letter dated June 26, 2013, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) issued Order EA-13-112, which modifies the FirstEnergy Nuclear Operating Company (FENOC) general license for the proposed Independent Spent Fuel Storage Installation (ISFSI) for the Beaver Valley Power Station (BVPS). The modification to the general license requires additional security measures for the physical protection of the proposed BVPS ISFSI.

In a July 15, 2013 letter, FENOC provided a response to Order EA-13-112, and within that response FENOC committed to report to the NRC when full compliance has been achieved with all of the additional security measures (ASMs) set forth in Attachment 1, Part D of Order EA-13-112. FENOC committed to implement the ASMs by June 26, 2014, or 90 days prior to the initial BVPS spent fuel cask load, whichever occurred first.

This letter serves as the formal notification that BVPS has completed all of the ASMs including approving the respective Security and Emergency Plan changes associated with the ASMs as committed to in the July 15, 2013 response letter.
