REVISIONS TO 10CFR73.71

Gentlemen:

On September 14, 1987, the Nuclear Regulatory Commission staff conducted a workshop to provide guidance to licensees concerning the implementation of the recently published revisions to 10CFR73.71. During the course of the meeting, the provisions of Draft Regulatory Guide 5.62 were discussed. Among other matters, the draft guide provides guidance as to what the staff considers to be an adequate compensatory measure for failures of security-related electronic and hardware devices. Further, licensees were advised that unless they reported compensatory measure conditions that deviate from the draft regulatory guide, although the compensatory measures may be acceptable within the NRC-approved security plans, there was risk of being cited as being in violation of the reporting requirements.

Carolina Power & Light Company maintains that so long as the Company complies with its NRC-approved Security Plans, the terms of our licenses, and the NRC's formal orders and regulations, no violation has occurred.

Carolina Power & Light Company will examine carefully the guidance provided in Regulatory Guide 5.62 when it is issued. However, the Company maintains that the only conditions that need to be reported are conditions that deviate from the NRC-approved Security Plans.
