INTERIM CRITERIA FOR SHIFT STAFFING

Dear Mr. Eisenhut:

We have reviewed your July 31, 1980 letter transmitting interim criteria for shift staffing and have assessed the compliance of each of our operating units to these criteria. The response of each plant is summarized below.

## H. B. Robinson

The Robinson Plant is not now in conformance with the interim guidelines for all shifts. While each shift always has the required total number of licensed personnel, on some shifts this complement is composed of a shift supervisor with an SRO and three ROs instead of the guideline staffing of two SROs and two ROs. Efforts are underway to alleviate this shortage of SROs, but because of the uncertainty of the criteria for qualification to take SRO examinations, CP&L believes it may not be able to reach full compliance with these interim guidelines at Robinson prior to July 1, 1982. CP&L is committed to achieving compliance with the guidelines as quickly as possible.

## Brunswick

The Brunswick Plant is currently operating in full compliance with the interim guidelines and plans to continue to do so.
