

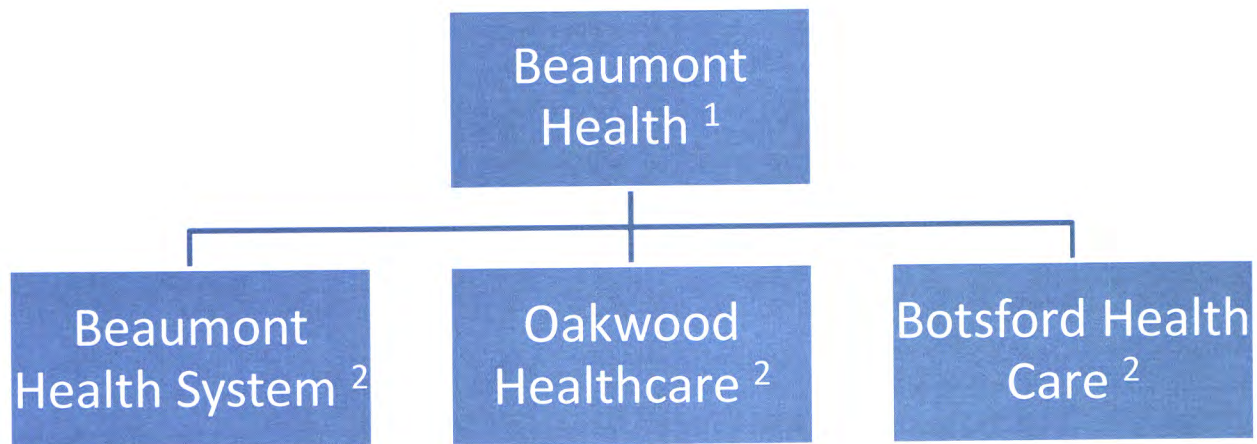

RE: Change of Control for NRC License Numbers 21-01333-01, 21-01333-02, 21-26392-01, 21-25833-01, 21-32616-01, and 21-20324-01

Dear Material License Reviewer:

William Beaumont Hospital doing business as Beaumont Health System (Beaumont) has entered into an affiliation agreement to combine their operations with Zieger Health Care Corporation also known as Botsford Health Care (Botsford) and Oakwood Healthcare, Inc. (Oakwood) following unanimous agreement by the three boards of directors. Under the terms of the affiliation agreement, the three organizations created a new, not-for-profit Michigan health system named Beaumont Health, Inc. (BHI). The new health system, BHI, will be governed by a single board and executive leadership structure with representation from the three organizations. BHI will become the sole member or owner of Beaumont, Botsford and Oakwood as illustrated below:

Beaumont President and CEO Gene Michalski will serve as initial CEO of BHI. State and federal regulatory approvals are pending. With these approvals, the organizations expect to close the transaction in the fall 2014.

The new BHI organization will have a combined eight hospitals with 3,337 beds, 153 outpatient sites, 5,000 physicians and 33,093 employees. The hospitals include:

- Beaumont Hospital, Royal Oak; Beaumont Hospital, Troy; Beaumont Hospital, Grosse Pointe
- Botsford Hospital, Farmington Hills
- Oakwood Hospital-Dearborn; Oakwood Hospital-Southshore; Oakwood Hospital-Taylor; and Oakwood Hospital-Wayne

We request written consent from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for the transfer of control of our NRC licenses:

The following documentation is provided in accordance with NUREG-1556, Vol. 15, Section 5.

5.1 Description of the Transaction

Beaumont is planning to remain intact and will retain all of its assets. BHI will become the sole member or owner of Beaumont.

The licensee contact for the transfer of control of the 6 NRC licenses listed above is Beaumont's Corporate Radiation Safety Officer, Cheryl Culver Schultz, M.S. Cheryl Culver Schultz can be reached at (248) 551-0548, if you have any questions or require additional information.

5.2 Changes in Personnel

No changes in personnel who have control over licensed activities at Beaumont are anticipated as a result of this transaction. There are no current plans to change the personnel including but not limited to the executive management, Chairperson of the Beaumont Radiation Safety Committee, Beaumont Corporate Radiation Safety Officer, Beaumont Gamma Knife Radiation Safety Officer, authorized users, or any other persons identified on NRC Licenses 21-01333-01, 21-01333-02, 21-26392-01, 21-25833-01, 21-32616-01, and 21-20324-01, or in these license applications as having responsibility for radiation safety or authorized use of licensed material.

5.3 Changes in Location, Equipment and Procedures

The NRC licensed program for Beaumont will continue to be managed by Beaumont and under the direct control of the Beaumont Radiation Safety Committee and the Beaumont Corporate Radiation Safety Officer. The locations authorized for licensed material under the Beaumont NRC Licenses, including the equipment, facilities where materials are used and stored, will not change. No relevant procedural changes are expected at this time.

5.4 Surveillance Records

The Corporate Radiation Safety Officer for Beaumont has reviewed the applicable surveillance requirements and records including leak tests, physical inventories, compliance audits,

dosimetry, radioactive waste and disposal, and instrument calibration records. All required surveillance has been performed, documented and reviewed.

5.5 Decommissioning and Related Records Transfer

Decommissioning will not occur as a result of this transaction or the affiliation agreement. BHI is aware of the extent and levels of contamination and the applicable decommissioning requirement. To the extent necessary and if Beaumont is unable to do so, BHI will accept full responsibility for any future decommissioning of the locations specified in NRC license nos. 21-01333-01 21-01333-02, 21-26392-01, 21-25833-01, 21-32616-01, and 21-20324-01, including any contamination of facilities and equipment.


5.6 Transferee's Commitment to Abide by the Transferor's Commitment


