NRC Names New Senior Resident Inspector at Point Beach Nuclear Station



The Nuclear Regulatory Commission has selected David Oliver as the new Senior Resident Inspector at the Point Beach Nuclear Power Plant in Two Rivers, Wis., approximately 13 miles northwest of Manitowoc. The nuclear power facility is operated by NextEra Energy. Oliver joined the NRC in 2011 as a licensing examiner for operators in Region III. Prior to joining the agency, he served nearly a decade in the U.S. Navy aboard the USS Enterprise and as an instructor at the Naval Nuclear Power Training Unit. Originally from Greenwood, Wis., Oliver holds a bachelor's degree in applied nuclear engineering technology from Thomas Edison State College. Most recently, he was a NRC- licensed senior reactor operator for a nuclear power plant in the Midwest.

“David Oliver is an excellent inspector with a firm commitment to safety. He will help the NRC fulfill its mission of protecting people and the environment by helping ensure the Point Beach plant follows the high safety standards set by the NRC,” said Region III Administrator Cynthia D. Pederson.

Each commercial nuclear power plant site in the United States has at least two NRC Resident Inspectors who monitor day-to-day operations at the plant.
