Dear Ms. McBurney:

We have reviewed the proposed changes to Part V, *Physical Protection of Category 1 and Category 2 Quantities of Radioactive Material*, received by our office on May 30, 2014. These regulations were reviewed by comparison to the equivalent U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) rules in 10 CFR Part 37. We discussed our review of the regulations with Bruce Hirschler on August 4, 2014.

As a result of our review, we have five comments that have been identified in the enclosure. Please note that we have limited our review to regulations required for compatibility and/or health and safety. Under our current procedure, a finding that the Conference of Radiation Control Program Directors' (CRCPD) regulations meet the compatibility and health and safety categories of the equivalent NRC regulations may only be made based on a review of the final CRCPD regulations. However, we have determined that if your proposed regulations were adopted, incorporating our comments and without other significant change, they would meet the compatibility and health and safety categories established in the Office of Federal and State Materials and Environmental Management Programs (FSME) Procedure SA-200, "Compatibility Categories and Health and Safety Identification for NRC Regulations and Other Program Elements."

We request that when the proposed regulations are adopted and published as final regulations, a copy of the "as published" regulations be provided to us for review and federal concurrence. As requested in FSME Procedure SA-201, "Review of State Regulatory Requirements," please highlight the final changes, and provide a copy to Division of Materials Safety and State Agreements, FSME.
