Enclosed is an application (XSNM3672/02), dated July 7, 2014, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from the U.S. Department of Energy's Y-12 National Security Complex, requesting amendment No. 2 to its existing license, XSNM3672/01. The license presently authorizes the export of 237.3 kilograms uranium-235 contained in 1189.5 kilograms uranium, enriched to 19.95 weight % maximum, to Canada for reload fuel for National Research Universal Reactor.

The purpose of the amendment is to change the name of one of the other U.S. parties to the export from B & W Y-12 LLC to Consolidated Nuclear Security LLC. There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested; therefore, our office is processing this as minor amendment. The NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
