Good afternoon. I am Commissioner Ostendorff's Legal Counsel. It has come to my attention that one of the proposed topics for the May 6th Diablo Canyon drop-in with Commissioner Ostendorff is "Seismic Studies and Diablo Canyon License Renewal." I would like to echo the *ex parte* concerns raised by my colleague, Roger Davis. Due to the ongoing adjudicatory proceeding on the Diablo Canyon license renewal, and the concern that an acceptable status discussion on seismic studies could inadvertently move into an unacceptable discussion about the merits of the seismic study, I would request that the topic of seismic studies be removed from the drop-in schedule.
