SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF JUNE 26, 2014, PUBLIC MEETING TO UPDATE

THE NUCLEAR REGULATORY COMMISSION (NRC)

RISK-INFORMED STEERING COMMITTEE (RISC), INDUSTRY RISC AND PUBLIC ON PROGRESS OF THE WORKING GROUPS

On June 26, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting at the NRC headquarters location in Rockville, Maryland to provide an update on progress of the Risk-Informed Steering Committee (RISC) working groups.

Each working group made presentations outlining their draft action plans that were developed using the approved problem statements. The Probabilistic Risk Assessment Technical Adequacy Working Group presentation is available in the Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML14178B245. The Treatment of Uncertainty in Decision Making Working Group presentation is available in ADAMS Accession Number ML14178B243. Both the NRC and Industry RISC members provided comments and direction on the path forward. The working groups will continue to hold public meetings to collaborate on the action plans and provide periodic updates to the RISC's.

The meeting was attended by 43 individuals, primarily representing industry, non-governmental organizations, and NRC staff. There was no feedback from the public during the meeting and no feedback forms were received after the meeting.

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Opening Comments

Eric Leeds provided the opening comments for the meeting with the recognition that the working groups have continued to work well together in a professional manner. Mr. Leeds also reflected on the realization that with the upcoming work associated with the working groups, the relationship building will help when there is disagreement among the members of the respective groups.

Maria Korsnick provided the opening comments for the industry echoing the comments provided by Mr. Leeds in commending the groups for their continued cooperation. Ms. Korsnick also reminded the members of the RISC's that the vision discussed at the beginning of this effort would be transformational change, not incremental.

PRA Technical Adequacy Working Group

The working group leads provided a presentation on their progress to date. The action plan has three objectives:

- 1. Develop a process suitable for making new methods available for risk-informed regulatory applications
- 2. Improve process for documentation and closure of Peer Review Facts and Observations (F&Os)
- 3. Evaluate any additional gaps in current peer review process

The RISC members of both committees asked questions and provided comments, but overall the consensus was that the group was on the right track with their action plan.

Treatment of Uncertainty in Decision Making Working Group

The working group leads provided a presentation on their progress to date. The action plan has four objectives:

- 1. Identify the specific causes for not being able to appropriately treat uncertainties in current risk-informed applications
- 2. Evaluate current approaches to addressing uncertainties in risk-informed decision-making and identify any gaps that need to be resolved
- 3. Propose enhancements to existing framework for addressing practical aspects of the treatment of uncertainty in risk-informed decision-making
- 4. Identify potential education mechanisms for both PRA practitioners and broader audiences, with respect to the treatment of uncertainty

The NRC working group lead stressed that the real focus of the group is to capture the full range of issues and let the steering committees decide the specific issues to be addressed by the group. RISC members of both committees asked questions and provided comments to the working group to guide their action plan development.

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Closing Comments

Tony Pietrangelo of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) provided closing comments once again complimenting the progress that has been achieved to date by the two working groups. Mr. Pietrangelo also took the time to thank Mr. Leeds for his public service and to wish him success in his future endeavors.

Mr. Leeds provided closing comments for the meeting thanking Mr. Peitrangelo for the comments and sharing in the gratitude for the working group's progress so far. Mr. Leeds remarked that the working groups would eventually provide documented guidance and stronger tools for the NRC and licensees to use when addressing a question from the public regarding what the anticipated outcome of the groups would be. Mr. Leeds also commented that the NRC RISC is exploring how this group will interface with the risk-management regulatory framework effort.
