SUBJECT: U.S. EPR DESIGN CERTIFICATION APPLICATION – ADVANCED SAFETY EVALUATION WITH NO OPEN ITEMS FOR CHAPTER 2, "SITE CHARACTERISTICS"

Dear Mr. Salas:

By letter dated December 11, 2007, as supplemented by letters dated February 7, 2008, and February 20, 2008, AREVA Inc. (AREVA) submitted an application to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) for a standard design certification (DC) of the U.S. EPR, pursuant to Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 52, "Licenses, Certifications, and Approvals for Nuclear Power Plants." Subsequent to the original application, AREVA submitted Revision 6 of the U.S. EPR Final Safety Analysis Report (FSAR) by letter dated April 3, 2014 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS) Accession Number ML14104A853). FSAR Revision 6 includes changes associated with responses to NRC Requests for Additional Information (RAIs) submitted through March 2014.

Based on its review of the application, the NRC staff prepared the enclosed Advanced Safety Evaluation (ASE) with no Open Items (OIs) (ADAMS Accession Number ML101100363), for Chapter 2, "Site Characteristics." Unless otherwise stated in the ASE, the NRC staff's review was based on Revision 6 of the application and AREVA's responses to RAIs. The ASE is being provided to support a meeting of the subcommittee of the Advisory Committee on Reactor Safeguards (ACRS) and a meeting date has yet to be determined. Issuance of this ASE is an important milestone in the NRC staff's review to determine whether AREVA's application meets the Commission's regulations.

The NRC staff concludes that the enclosed ASE with no OIs does not contain any information for which exemption from public disclosure has been sought or approved. However, the NRC will withhold the enclosed ASE from public disclosure for ten calendar days from the date of this letter to allow you the opportunity to verify the staff's conclusion that the ASE contains no such exempt information.

If within that time, you do not request that all or portions of the ASE with no OIs be withheld from public disclosure in accordance with 10 CFR 2.390, "Public Inspections, Exemptions, Requests for Withholding," the enclosure will be made available for public inspection through the NRC Public Document Room and the Publicly Available Records component of the NRC ADAMS web site. ADAMS is accessible from the Public Electronic Reading Room section of the NRC web site at http://www.nrc.gov/reading-rm/adams.html.
