Land Quality Division, District 3 personnel completed a review of Cameco's cover letter dated May 23, 2014. Cameco's letter has requested a frequency change to the monitor well sampling as approved in Section 2.1.6 of the research proposal for Mine Unit 4.

With receipt of this letter, Cameco may reduce the sampling frequency from twice a month to the 60 day sampling frequency during the groundwater restoration of Mine Unit 4.
