SUMMARY

By application dated May 21, 2014, AREVA Federal Services, LLC (AREVA) requested renewal of Certificate of Compliance No. 9184, for the Model No. PAS-1 package. AREVA did not request any changes to the package design or its authorized contents. The certificate has been renewed for a five year term.

EVALUATION

The staff reviewed the documents referenced in the certificate and determined that the documentation was available and complete. The staff also reviewed the operating and maintenance procedures for the package submitted by the certificate holder, and found them to be complete and adequate.

CONDITIONS

Condition No. 9 has been revised to reflect the new certificate expiration date.

The references section has been updated to include the date of the certificate renewal request.

CONCLUSION

The certificate has been renewed for a five year term, which expires on August 31, 2019. Based on the statements contained in the application, and the conditions listed above, the staff concludes that the changes indicated do not affect the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71.
