The Programmatic Agreement (PA) regarding the Dewey-Burdock ISR Project was executed in April 2014. The NRC staff appreciates your efforts in the development and finalization of that document. Prior to the development of the treatment plans for the Dewey-Burdock ISR Project, the NRC staff would like to engage all consulting parties in determining what treatment measures are appropriate for each adversely affected historic property.
