REGARDING: NRC Amendment for Martin Army Replacement Hospital (583969)

Effective August 1, 2014, Dr. Glen Vahjen is designated the interim Radiation Safety Officer, Martin Army Hospital, Fort Benning, GA. Please update our license as needed. Dr. Vahjen will serve as the interim RSO until the incoming RSO reports for duty in approximately two weeks.

With respect to the issue of I-131 use at the new hospital, we have decided today to delay application for use of I-131 until a later time. We plan to reevaluate our need for I131 in approximately 9-12 months. We still plan to resubmit our application for amendment for the MACH Replacement Hospital as discussed, unless the removal of I-131 from consideration alters that plan.
