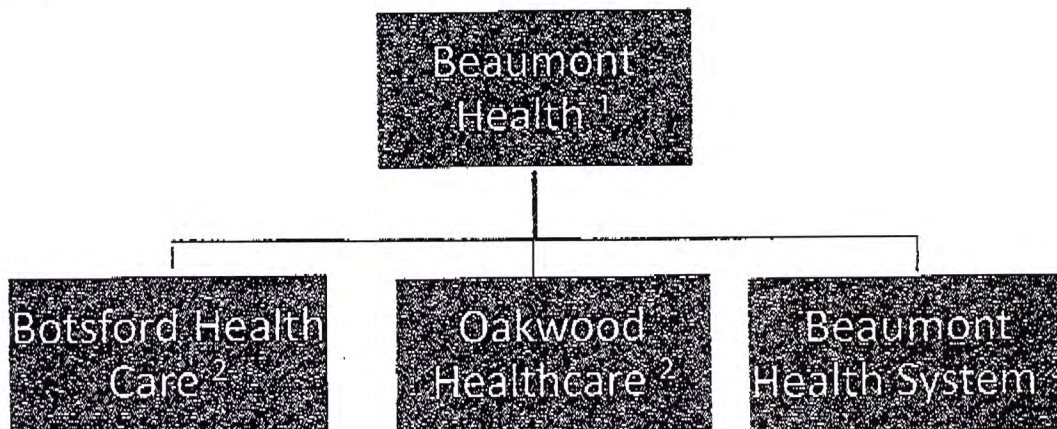

RE: Change of Control for NRC License Number 21-08892-01
Follow Up to Notice of Change of Organizational Structure Request Dated August 4, 2014

Dear Material License Reviewer:

Zieger Health Care Corporation sole member of Botsford Health Care (Botsford) has entered into an affiliation agreement to combine Botsford's operations with Oakwood Healthcare, Inc. (Oakwood) and William Beaumont Hospital doing business as Beaumont Health System (Beaumont) following unanimous agreement by the three boards of directors. Under the terms of the affiliation agreement, the three organizations created a new, not-for-profit Michigan health system named Beaumont Health, Inc. (BH). The new health system, BH, will be governed by a single board and executive leadership structure with representation from the three organizations. BH will become the sole member or owner of Botsford, Oakwood and Beaumont, as illustrated below:

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As a result of the transaction, BH will directly become the sole member (or owner) of Botsford. There will be no name change to Botsford's NRC License, which will remain Botsford General Hospital.

We request written consent from the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission for the direct transfer of control of our NRC License No. 21-08892-01. The following documentation is provided in accordance with NUREG-1556, Vol. 15, Section 5.

5.1 Description of the Transaction

Botsford is planning to remain intact and will retain all of its assets. BH will become the sole member or owner of Beaumont. The licensee contact for the transfer of control of Botsford is the Radiation Safety Officer, Timothy Allen McKnight, D.O.

5.2 Changes in Personnel

No changes in personnel who have control over licensed activities at Botsford are anticipated as a result of this transaction. There are no current plans to change the personnel including but not limited to the executive management, the Radiation Safety Officer, the Radiation Safety Officer for the high dose rate remote afterloader unit, Stephan Morse, D.O., authorized users, authorized medical physicists and any other persons identified on NRC License 21-08892-01, or in the license application as having responsibility for radiation safety or authorized use of licensed material.

5.3 Changes in Location, Equipment and Procedures

The NRC licensed program for Botsford will continue to be managed by Botsford and under the direct control of the Radiation Safety Officer, Timothy Allen McKnight, D.O., and the Radiation Safety Officer for the high dose rate remote afterloader unit, Stephan Morse, D.O. The locations authorized for licensed material under Botsford's NRC Licenses, including the equipment, facilities where materials are used and stored, will not change. No relevant procedural changes are expected at this time.

5.4 Surveillance Records

The Radiation Safety Officer for Botsford has reviewed the applicable surveillance requirements and records including leak tests, physical inventories, compliance audits, dosimetry, radioactive waste and disposal, and instrument calibration records. All required surveillance has been performed, documented and reviewed.

5.5 Decommissioning and Related Records Transfer

Decommissioning will not occur as a result of this transaction or the affiliation agreement. BH is aware of the extent and levels of contamination and the applicable decommissioning requirement. To the extent necessary and if Botsford is unable to do so, BH will accept full responsibility for any future decommissioning of the locations specified in NRC license no. 21-08892-01, including any contamination of facilities and equipment.

5.6 Transferee's Commitment to Abide by the Transferor's Commitment


BH will comply with the Botsford NRC License conditions stipulated in 21-08892-01.
