Dear Mr. Reichhold:

Thank you for your correspondence dated August 5, 2014. This letter serves as the response of William Beaumont Hospital doing business as Beaumont Health System (Beaumont) to your additional inquiries.

As you are aware, Beaumont entered into an affiliation agreement with Zieger Health Care Corporation also known as Botsford Health Care (Botsford) and Oakwood Healthcare Corporation (Oakwood). Under the terms of the affiliation agreement, the three organizations created a new, not-for-profit Michigan health system named Beaumont Health (BH). The closing of this transaction is currently scheduled for September 1, 2014.


As a result of the transaction, BH will directly become the sole member (or owner) of Beaumont. There will be no name change to any of Beaumont's NRC License Numbers, which will remain in Beaumont's name.

Because BH will become the sole member (or owner) of Botsford and Oakwood, you have asked that both Botsford and Oakwood sign the change of control agreement indicating their agreement that BH will comply with Beaumont NRC License conditions stipulated in 21-01333-01, 21-01333-02, 21-26392-01, 21-25833-01, 21-32616-01, and 21-20324-01, which is indicated by their signatures below. Botsford and Oakwood already have separately filed applications with the NRC with respect to their NRC licenses.



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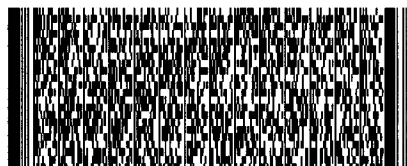
