PROGRAM SCOPE								

This was routine inspection of a mobile nuclear medicine service provider authorized to use licensed material permitted by Sections 35.100 and 35.200 for imaging procedures. The licensee performed a full spectrum of diagnostic studies with the majority of cases involving cardiac imaging (typically 150 cases per month). The licensee performed studies on Fridays at its Greenfield Road clinic and operated a scan-in-van mobile service utilizing 3-4 coaches in in State of Michigan. Imaging studies were performed daily either in the van or within the clients' facilities. The nuclear medicine group was staffed with 6 PRN technologists. The licensee received unit doses from a licensed radiopharmacy. The licensee retained the services of a consulting physicist who audited the radiation safety program on a quarterly basis (last 6/17/2014).

This inspection consisted of interviews with licensee personnel, independent measurements, and a review of select records. The inspection included observations of licensed activities at a temporary job site. The inspector observed licensee personnel maintain security of its RAM, utilize personnel monitoring, and administer unit dosages for cardiac imaging.

No violations of NRC requirements were identified during this inspection.
