PROGRAM SCOPE

This was a routine inspection of an engineering consulting services company authorized to use a variety of portable moisture density gauges at temporary job sites within NRC jurisdiction. At the time of the inspection, the licensee stored its licensed material outside of NRC jurisdiction at offices in Buffalo Grove and Bridgeview, Illinois, and in Sturtevant, Wisconsin. The RSO was based in Buffalo Grove, while the gauges and authorized users who conducted licensed activities in NRC jurisdiction (primarily Northwest Indiana) were based in Bridgeview. The licensee possessed a survey meter for use in the evaluation of public dose and for use in emergencies, and maintained quarterly dosimetry for authorized gauge users and for area monitoring.

PERFORMANCE OBSERVATIONS

On August 22, 2014, the inspector visited the licensee's offices in Buffalo Grove and Bridgeview, Illinois. The inspector was not able to observe the conduct of licensed activities in NRC jurisdiction during the inspection, as none had been scheduled for that day. However, the licensee project management staff did offer to notify the inspector when density measurements were to be scheduled at one of two active construction sites in Merrillville, Indiana. The inspector interviewed one of the three authorized user in Bridgeview who had recently performed licensed activities in NRC jurisdiction. Through demonstrations of gauge use, transportation, and emergency response, the inspector found the individual to be knowledgeable of radiation protection principles and regulatory requirements. The inspector also interviewed the RSO, who was not available during the inspection, by telephone on August 27, 2014. The individual demonstrated an adequate level of oversight for the radiation safety program.

The inspector reviewed a selection of records at the Bridgeview office pertaining to gauges and users involved in licensed activities in NRC jurisdiction. The records included inventories, leak tests, shipping papers, dosimetry, training records, gauge user audits field audits, and annual facility audits.

The inspector closed a violation of Condition 12 of NRC License No. 12-32696-01, cited previously in IR 03037767/2009001(DNMS). No other violations of NRC requirements were identified as a result of this inspection.
