Tom Magette from Energy Solutions (ES) called this morning – after their drop-in with Commissioner Svinicki. I wanted to ensure you were aware that ES will offer their perspective on the overall changes to Part 61 – in addition to the concerns they have with the Period of Performance issue on the Limited Rulemaking.

ES understands there is little chance Part 61 will actually go through an update – given other priorities and given the potential level of effort associated with such an update.

But ES believes great progress can be made with this limited rulemaking in lieu of an overhaul of Part 61. But they do not see the staff approaching the Commission to make such a recommendation. Currently – the staff has direction to develop the limited rulemaking and provide a plan for how Part 61 might be updated.

The attached comments get to what their suggestion entails. In a nutshell – they recommend that an overall change be made to Part 61 to allow for the creation of site-specific WAC that would serve as the regulatory standard for the waste streams that could be safely disposed in any given facility. They believe this change will improve the effectiveness of the current rulemaking and eliminate the need for a future rulemaking – still currently under consideration.

I believe – based on some of the dialogue I have had with others in the waste community – this might be a message from others also.

The purpose of the meeting was to introduce David Lockwood, the new President and CEO and Victoria Napier the Vice President of Federal Government Relations. EnergySolutions also provided a brief status of the Zion decommissioning activities which are on track and on budget, expressed concern about the NRC staff using a 10,000 year compliance period for the proposed 10 CFR Part 61 revisions and the need for Agreement State Compatibility of "B" for the proposed rulemaking to ensure an adequate National program.

The Commissioner encouraged Energy Solutions to formally comment on the proposed rule when it is issued.

No policy decisions were made during this meeting.
