DECLARATION OF

JILL DENTON

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I, Jill Denton, declare as follows:

1. I am a resident of Los Osos, California. I own a house at 1724 13th in St Los Osos and have resided at this house with my spouse Caroline Hall since 1994. My spouse and I have lived in Los Osos since 1992, having moved to the 13th St address after living a few blocks away for two years. We have several beloved pets that I am concerned about being able to evacuate following an accident at Diablo Canyon.
2. My phone number is 805-534-1101
3. I am currently a member of Friends of the Earth ("FOE"), and have been a member since October 2013.
4. I understand that among its missions, FOE seeks to ensure that the public has an opportunity to influence the outcome of governmental and corporate decisions that affect the lives of many people.
5. My home is about 8 miles from Diablo Canyon Power Plant ("Diablo Canyon"). I am a licensed marriage and family therapist.
6. My spouse, Rev. Dr. Caroline Hall, is rector of Saint Benedict's Episcopal Church in Los Osos. Caroline's leadership role at St. Benedict's means that our family extends far beyond our private home. We both regularly care for members of Saint Benedict's who require extra assistance, particularly elderly and home-bound parishioners. These people are extended family to us and we care very much about their welfare.
7. My personal health and safety and my family's personal health and safety will be seriously affected in the event that an earthquake damages Diablo Canyon and causes a radiation leak from the plant. Diablo Canyon's operation without adequate assurance that its essential structures will continue to operate and that the plant can be safely shut down in the event of an earthquake caused by one of the faults near the plant poses a significant risk to my personal health and safety and my family's health and safety. I am very worried about the impossibility of evacuating Los Osos following an accident at Diablo Canyon. There are only two roads leading out of Los Osos and they will both likely be bottlenecks following a radioactive release. I worry about what would happen to the elderly and home-bound parishioners whom Caroline and I look after, as I know we

would not be able to assist everyone who needs to leave the area. I am also very concerned that Caroline and I may not be able to get our cats, birds, and dog to safety as the evacuation location stipulated by Pacific Gas and Electric in their emergency planning materials does not accept pets. I am also concerned about the well being of other domestic animals in the area following an accident at Diablo Canyon, particularly the many horses stabled near Montana De Oro.


8. In addition to our home at 1724 13th St., my spouse and I also own a vacant lot on 8th St. in Los Osos and the building where my counseling practice is located. In addition to housing my counseling practice, we also rent space in our building at 2015 9th St. in Los Osos to another business and two tenants. The value of my home and lot will be adversely affected in the event of an earthquake and subsequent release or threatened release of radioactivity at Diablo Canyon. The value of my rental property, where my counseling practice is located, and its assets will be adversely affected in the event of an earthquake and subsequent release or threatened release of radioactivity from Diablo Canyon.
9. I moved to Los Osos because of its unique natural beauty and regularly enjoy hiking and kayaking in the areas surrounding Diablo Canyon. Almost every day my spouse and I take our dog for walks through the Irish Hills and ^{NEAR} Montana De Oro, just north of Diablo Canyon.
10. The natural beauty and recreational offerings that bring tourists to the central coast would be profoundly diminished following an accident at Diablo Canyon, driving tourists away and negatively impacting the local economy. My personal income would be impacted by an accident at Diablo Canyon, as most of my clients would likely leave the area.
11. My spouse and I both have a history of action to protect and restore the environment surrounding Diablo Canyon. In addition to supporting a host of environmental organizations including FoE, Mothers for Peace, the Land Conservancy of San Luis Obispo County, the Sierra Club, and the Morro Bay National Estuary Program, we both frequently take personal actions to improve the local environment. We have done maintenance on local trails and have done water sampling around the Morro Bay watershed. I am also active in protesting environmentally damaging practices. I've been

protesting Diablo Canyon's operation since the 1980s and have taken on new fights over the years such as stopping the practice of hydraulic fracturing to extract fossil fuels.

12. The continuing operation of Diablo Canyon without amendments to the license to ensure that Diablo Canyon can withstand earthquakes caused by the Shoreline, Los Osos and San Luis Faults, as called for in the Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations, poses a significant risk to my personal health and safety, the health and safety of my family, the market value of my home and business, and my interest in enjoying and protecting the environment around Diablo Canyon.
13. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's failure to provide a public hearing with regard to analysis of the newly discovered Shoreline, Los Osos and San Luis Faults has denied me the right to participate in proceedings to protect my personal health and safety, the health and safety of my family, the market value of my home and business, and my interest in enjoying and protecting the environment around Diablo Canyon.
14. I authorize FoE to petition to intervene in this proceeding on my behalf. I authorize FoE on my behalf to request that the Nuclear Regulatory Commission hold a public hearing regarding the safety of Diablo Canyon.
15. I strongly support the petition to intervene and request for a hearing filed by FoE with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission regarding Diablo Canyon.
