It turns out that of the 2 damaged cartons, most of the individual 20-tab boxes just had slight indentations without compromising the foil/tablets inside. Only 1 (one) 20-tab box was damaged. We can absorb that no other action is needed in this regard.

Will it be possible for you to send me the government rate per tablet? Our financial folks require it of federally-provided inventory items.

Hi Trish and Annette:

The good news is that the KI delivery was made to Virginia. We are in the process of inventorying the cartons shipped to us. I have two questions:

1. Two cartons came damaged, with some of the boxes crushed and some of them intact. Do we return these or discard the unusable boxes, and can they be replaced by the NRC?
2. What is the government cost/rate of the tablets received? The shipment some years ago for the 65mg tablets was \$0.2615/tablet but I would think that might have changed.
