OF TIME TO REACH FINAL SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT


On July 21, 1998, the Atomic Safety and Licensing Board issued a Memorandum and Order extending the stay in the captioned proceeding. The Board stated that if the parties were unable to reach final agreement by July 31, 1998, they should so notify the Board.

The parties continue to make substantial progress in their negotiations but have not yet succeeded in reaching final agreement. In particular, counsel for Dr. Elamir has just learned that Dr. Elamir is out of the country and unavailable to discuss these matters with his counsel until on or about August 3, 1998. The parties believe that additional time may well allow them to reach a final agreement in this matter.


