SUBJECT: ACCEPTANCE REVIEW OF SOUTHERN NUCLEAR OPERATING COMPANY'S  
REQUEST FOR LICENSE AMENDMENT AND EXEMPTION (LAR 13-038) FOR  
THE VOGTLE ELECTRIC GENERATING PLANT UNITS 3 AND 4: ANNEX  
BUILDING STRUCTURE AND LAYOUT CHANGES (TAC NO. RP9486)

Dear Mr. Ivey:

By letter dated August 22, 2014 (Agencywide Documents Access and Management System under Accession No. ML14234A423), and revised by letter dated September 23, 2014 (ADAMS Accession No. ML14266A656) Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) submitted a license amendment request (LAR) to Combined License (COL) Numbers NPF-91 and NPF-92, for the Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP), Units 3 and 4, respectively. The license amendment request consists of changes to the Updated Final Safety Analysis Report (UFSAR) in the form of departures from the incorporated plant-specific Design Control Document (DCD) Tier 2 information and involves changes to Tier 2\* and Tier 1 information, with corresponding changes in associated COL Appendix C information. The proposed changes include:

- (a) Installation of an additional non-safety-related battery,
- (b) Revision to the annex building internal configuration by converting a shift turnover room to a battery room, adding an additional battery equipment room, and moving a fire area wall;
- (c) Increase in the height of a room in the annex building; and
- (d) Increase in thicknesses of certain floor of the annex building.

In addition, the proposed changes also include reconfiguring existing rooms and related room, wall, and access path changes.

SNC has also requested an exemption from the provisions of Title 10 of the *Code of Federal Regulations* (10 CFR) Part 52, Appendix D, Section III.B, "Design Certification Rule for the AP1000 Design, Scope and Contents," to allow a departure from the elements of the certification information in Tier 1 of the generic DCD.

The purpose of this letter is to provide the results of the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff's acceptance review of this LAR. The acceptance review was performed to determine if there is sufficient technical information in scope and depth to allow the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical reviews. The acceptance review is also intended to identify whether the application has any readily apparent information insufficiencies in its characterization of the regulatory requirements or the licensing basis of the plant.

Consistent with Section 50.90 of the 10 CFR, an amendment to the license must fully describe the changes requested, and follow as far as applicable, the form prescribed for original applications. Section 52.79 of the 10 CFR addresses the content of technical information required. This section stipulates that the submittal address the design and operating characteristics, unusual or novel design features, and principal safety considerations.

The NRC staff has reviewed your application and concluded that it does provide technical information in sufficient detail to enable the NRC staff to complete its detailed technical review and make an independent assessment regarding the acceptability, of the proposed amendment in terms of regulatory requirements and the protection of public health and safety and the environment.

Given the lesser scope and depth of the acceptance review as compared to the detailed technical review, there may be instances in which issues that impact the NRC staff's ability to complete the detailed technical review are identified despite completion of an adequate acceptance review. You will be advised of any further information needed to support the NRC staff's detailed technical review by separate correspondence.
