
To Whom it May Concern:

This letter is in response to the violation notice that we received from your office dated April 14, 2014. In this letter, your office stated that we were still in violation of not keeping a physical inventory of the Seaman gauges. This office does not contend that this violation still existed during Ms. Gaskins visit on March 11, 2014. During the inspection by your office in April 2013 there were multiple violations documented. GM2 Associates attempted to correct these various violations but apparently missed this physical inventory item. This was an oversight on our end.

After the March 11, 2014 inspection, a physical inventory of the two Seaman gauges has been created. Starting on April 15, 2014 a semiannual inventory program has been started. This inventory includes the radionuclides, quantities, manufacturer's name and model numbers, leak tests, as well as the date of the inventory. The next date of inventory is October 15, 2014.

We hope that this response satisfies your requirements for GM2 in response to what needs to be corrected with or Nuclear Gauge Programs. If you have any questions or concerns, please do not hesitate to contact me.
