Re: Strata uranium mining in Crook County, WY

Dear Board Members:

NRC's EIS is incomplete.

The risks to aquifer restoration is very unclear:

- Baseline groundwater assessment is left inaccurate.
- Improperly plugged and unplugged previous exploration wells and drill holes are not carefully analyzed for conduit contamination into water sources.
- Other uranium projects in the U.S. failed to restore aquifers to pre-mining water quality. This EIS does not show that Strata will be any different.

There is no substitute for healthy water!!! People expect the Safety part of your Board to do a thorough job of protecting all water sources. I am asking you to do so.
