Dear Consulting Parties,

On July 30, 2014, the NRC staff transmitted the attached table via e-mail for your review and requested any suggestions you could provide concerning potential measures to avoid, minimize, or mitigate adverse effects on historic properties. After following up with tribal staff via telephone, the NRC staff notes that a number of personnel changes in the Tribal Historic Preservation Offices have recently occurred.
