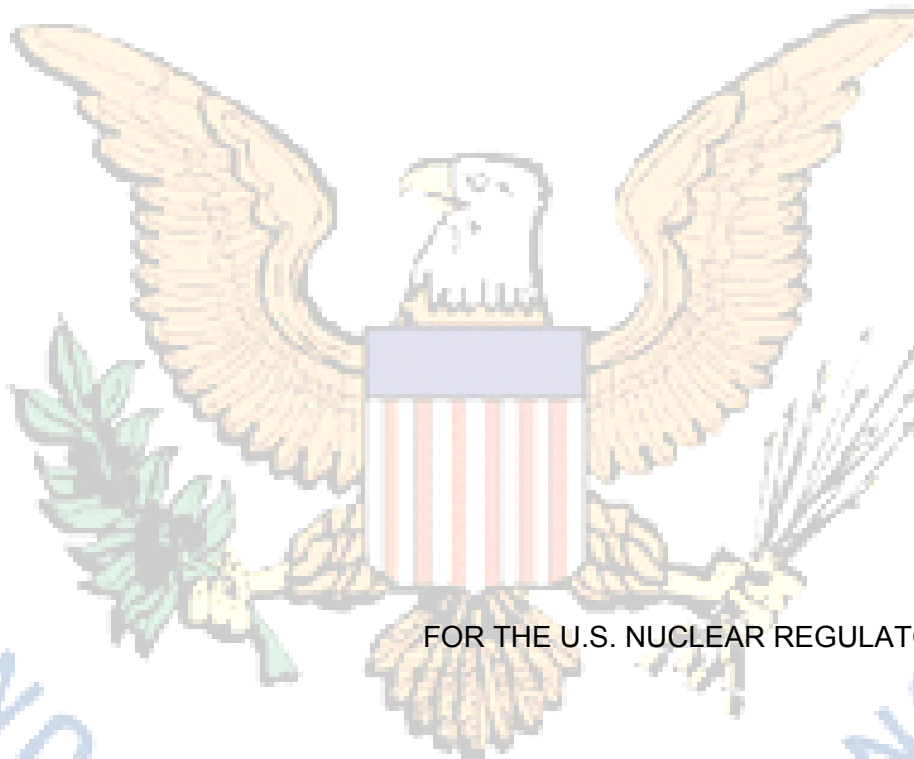
Pursuant to Section 32.14, 10 CFR Part 32, "Specific Domestic Licenses to Manufacture or Transfer Certain Items Containing Byproduct Material," Fusion UV Systems, Inc., is authorized to distribute electron tubes containing not more than 30 microcuries of krypton-85, to persons exempt from licensing pursuant to Section 30.15 of 10 CFR Part 30, or equivalent provisions of the regulations of any Agreement State.

CONDITIONS

- 10. This license does not authorize possession or use of licensed material.
- 11. The licensee is authorized to distribute only from its facilities located at 910 Clopper Road, Gaithersburg, MD.
