On July 22, 1999 the Nebraska Department of Environmental Quality received a submittal of information from Crow Butte Resources, Inc. The submittal was the final report for the six-month stabilization period of the I-196 shallow excursion.

The Department has reviewed all of the information submitted and determined that the affected waters have been returned to or brought within acceptable levels of baseline conditions. Therefore, restoration efforts at the I-196 shallow excursion have been successful.

The Department hereby accepts the restoration of the I-196 shallow excursion area. All monitoring wells associated with the restoration activities (196a through 196o) shall be abandoned according to Title 178, Chapter 12.
