Dear Chairman Azure:

Enclosed please find letters sent via email to the Tribal Historic Preservation Officers. In the letters, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff requested input of all consulting parties, including consulting Tribes, in determining what treatment measures are appropriate for each adversely affected historic property at the Dewey-Burdock In Situ Uranium Recovery (ISR) project site.

As contemplated by the Programmatic Agreement (PA) that was executed in April 2014, the NRC staff is coordinating with the consulting parties on developing treatment measures for historic properties at the Dewey-Burdock site. The email solicited suggestions concerning potential measures to avoid, minimize, or mitigate adverse effects on historic properties. At this time, the NRC staff has not received a response from your Tribe. The NRC staff will follow up with your staff via telephone to request tribal input on the treatment measures.

The NRC staff is transmitting this letter and attached correspondence to you to keep you informed of activities related to the implementation of the terms of the PA for the Dewey-Burdock ISR Project.
