Status of Recommendation

Recommendation 2:

Revise NRC Management Directive 2.8 to include:

- Current IT governance stakeholder requirements.
- A definition of IT governance, structure, and processes.

Status:

The Office of Information Services (OIS) has worked with the Office of Administration on establishing a timeline for a Management Directive (MD) 2.x release that will meet the February 2016 target completion date. An OIS working group has drafted the first revision to the MD, subsequent handbooks, and supporting online guidance. The working group will continue to work across OIS and eventually across the agency to bring the policy into practice. Processes supporting the handbooks are currently under development within the relevant functional organizations within OIS. Each organization will provide Web access to processes, procedures, roles, and responsibilities, pending availability of funds.

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Status of Recommendation

Recommendation 3:

Update and finalize the CONOPS to be consistent with current practice, including a schedule for full implementation.

Status:

The Office of Information Services (OIS) has conducted a series of facilitated sessions, workshops, and interviews which have resulted in the development of process models for all reported OIS functions. OIS has established a phased implementation plan for a Web-based version of the Concept of Operations (CONOPS) process models that is dependent on the implementation of a new Web-based infrastructure (the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission's new Intranet environment). Full Web-based deployment of the process model depiction will be phased in based on the availability of this infrastructure. Prior to this deployment, OIS will be providing hardcopy process and procedure documentation that encapsulates the process model information, and all the detailed documentation will be available from a shared network location. OIS expects to make additional refinements to the process models as staff does periodic reviews, performs further analysis, resolves open issues, changes processes or procedures, and adds new functions.
