In Reference 1, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) requested that the review fees be waived in pursuit of being the plant to pilot a simplified risk-informed (RI) approach for closure of GSI-191 under the provisions of 10 CFR 170.11(a)(12), "a performance assessment or evaluation for which the licensee volunteers at the NRC's request and which is selected by the NRC."

Based on discussions with the NRC, PG&E has determined that it no longer intends to pursue pilot plant status for the simplified RI approach and therefore withdraws its fee waiver request.

This letter contains no new regulatory commitments and no new revisions to existing regulatory commitments (as defined in NEI 99-04).
