The NRC Staff wishes to inform you that it has issued Supplement 2 to the Safety Evaluation Report Related to the License Renewal of Indian Point Nuclear Generating Units 2 and 3, NUREG-1930, Supplement 2 (Nov. 2014). As the Staff has indicated previously, SER Supplement 2 addresses changes made to the license renewal application ("LRA") and information provided by Entergy Nuclear Operations, Inc. ("Entergy") since the issuance of SER Supplement 1 in October 2011; this includes the Staff's evaluation of Entergy's aging management program for Reactor Vessel Internals.

SER Supplement 2 has been placed in the NRC's Agencywide Documents Access and Management System (ADAMS), and should be accessible on or before November 10, 2014, at ADAMS Accession Nos. ML14288A608 (letter) and ML14310A803 (SER Supplement 2).
