- SUBJECT: SUMMARY OF A PUBLIC MEETING WITH SOUTHERN NUCLEAR OPERATING COMPANY AND SOUTH CAROLINA ELECTRIC & GAS ON OCTOBER 30, 2014

The U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) staff held a Category 2 public meeting with Southern Nuclear Operating Company (SNC) and South Carolina Electric & Gas (SCE&G) on October 30, 2014. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss issues associated with the safety review of licensing actions for SNC's Vogtle Electric Generating Plant (VEGP), Units 3 and 4, and SCE&G's Virgil C. Summer Nuclear Station (VCSNS), Units 2 and 3.

Summary of Meeting:

On October 30, 2014, staff from the NRC conducted a public meeting with representatives from SNC and SCE&G to discuss issues associated with the safety review of licensing actions for SNC's VEGP Units 3 and 4, and SCE&G's VCSNS Units 2 and 3. Specifically, the meeting discussed the AP1000 licensees' responses to BL 2012-01, "Design Vulnerability in Electric Power System" and the AP1000 design's compliance with General Design Criteria (GDC) 17, "Electric Power Systems." The first topic discussed was the AP1000 licensees' responses to BL 2012-01. The staff had comments and questions regarding compliance with GDC 17. Specifically, the staff's questions focused on the licensees' inability to demonstrate, through analyses or tests, that the AP1000 design can detect an open phase condition for all modes of operation and all loading conditions. The licensees understood the staff's concerns and requested to have the staff issue a letter. The staff's position is that the licensees have not provided sufficient information for the staff to conclude that they satisfy the requirements of GDC 17 given this open phase condition vulnerability. The licensees will review the letter and consider their options to sufficiently address BL 2012-01.

The second topic discussed was SNC's LAR 14-006. The staff had comments and clarification questions regarding the proposed changes. SNC understood the staff's comments, and both parties agreed to have further discussions about the proposed changes identified in LAR 14-006 at a future public teleconference.

At the end of the meeting, there was an opportunity for the public to provide comments and ask questions. All comments and questions were addressed before ending the meeting.
