## Attachment

Violation:

Contrary to the requirements in the SNM-960 license, Section 5.8 - Criticality Safety Training, annual refresher training was not provided to personnel working with SNM in Criticality Limit Areas since 2011.

Response:

1) The reason for the violation

VNC has had limited SNM movements in the past several years. During that time, procedures were developed and followed to assure that only small, safe amounts of SNM were handled. Because of the small amount of material in use and the specific procedures and training provided, the radiological training procedure was updated to remove the annual refresher training requirement and instead required training if/when more than a small, safe amount were to be moved. As the procedure was being changed, VNC personnel did not also revise the license, so the procedure and practices were then out of compliance with the license.

- 2) Short term corrective actions taken (tracked in Condition Report 12888)
- A compliance calendar item was added on November 18, 2014 to provide an annual reminder of the need for annual training.
- Criticality refresher training of personnel was provided on November 19, 2014.
- The training procedure, VSS 8.1, was updated on November 19, 2014 to require annual refresher training.
- 3) Longer term preventive actions

None are required at this time. Once the SNM-960 license is renewed, training requirements will be revised as appropriate to be consistent with the renewed license.

4) The date when full compliance will be achieved

Full compliance was achieved November 19, 2014.
