Enclosed is an application, dated November 12, 2014, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, from AREVA Inc. In this application, AREVA Inc., requests an amendment to its existing license, XSOU8833. At present, the license authorizes the export of up to 750,000 kilograms of depleted uranium dioxide (UO₂) powder to AREVA's MELOX facility in France for mixed oxide fuel production activities.

This export is tracked and reported within the United States as: EURATOM obligated, LES obligated or a mixture of LES and EURATOM obligated.

No other changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license are requested; therefore, we intend to issue this minor amendment after the required 30-day time period allotted for public review expires and it is determined that the applicable export license criteria are met.
