Dear Ms. Henderson,

Please find attached a final regulation unique to Illinois that adds a pregnancy test requirement for certain thyroid patients in our 32 IAC 335.5010 (10 CFR 35.300 equivalent). The Agency has been involved in several events involving the administration of I-131 to patients who were subsequently found to be pregnant at the time of administration. NRC reviewed the draft version on August 3, 2012 and had no objections.

We believe that adoption of these revisions augments the health and safety aspects of our regulations and does not impact compatibility issues per FSME Procedure SA-200.
