The purpose of this modification is to:

1. Revise the reporting requirement period for the Federal Financial Reports and the Performance (technical) reports to a quarterly basis as follows: Under C- Standard Terms and Conditions;

a. Mandatory General Requirements; Monitoring and Reporting; b. Federal Financial Reports is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“The Grantee shall submit a “Federal finance report” (SF-425) on a quarterly basis for the periods ending March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31, or any portion thereof, unless otherwise specified in a special award condition. Reports are due no later than 30 days following the end of each reporting period. A final SF-425 is due within 90 days after expiration of the award. The report should be submitted electronically to: Grants_FFR@NRC.GOV. (NOTE: There is an underscore between Grants and FFR).”

b. Programmatic Requirements; Performance (technical) Reports, a and c are deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

“a. The Grantee shall submit performance (technical) reports electronically to the NRC Project Officer and Grants Officer on a quarterly basis unless otherwise authorized by the Grants Officer. Performance reports should be sent to the Program Officer at the email address indicated in Block 12 of the Notice Award, to the Grants Officer at: Grants_PPR.Resource@NRC.GOV. (NOTE: There is an underscore between Grants and PPR).”

“c. The Office of Chief Human Capital Officer (OCHCO) requires the submission of the quarterly progress report on the SF-PPR, SF-PPR-B, and the SF-PPR-E forms for the periods ending March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31, or any portion thereof, unless otherwise specified in a special award condition. Reports are due no later than 30 days following the end of each reporting period. A final report is due within 90 days after expiration of the award.”

2. Designate recipient as a High Risk Recipient. The following is inserted to the end of C- Standard Terms and Conditions:

SPECIAL AWARD CONDITIONS: In accordance with 2 CFR 215.15, the recipient will adhere to the following conditions to ensure success with future reporting activities and with the scholarship program. The conditions are as follows:

1. The recipient will submit a comprehensive statement describing how it intends to monitor its scholarship students.
2. The recipient will submit a comprehensive statement describing how it intends to ensure the accuracy of its progress and metrics reporting.
3. Progress reports will be due quarterly, rather than semi-annually.
4. The recipient will agree to engage NRC's Office of Small Business & Civil Rights (SBCR) Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) Program to obtain assistance and support efforts to achieve academic excellence and produce a diverse STEM workforce.
