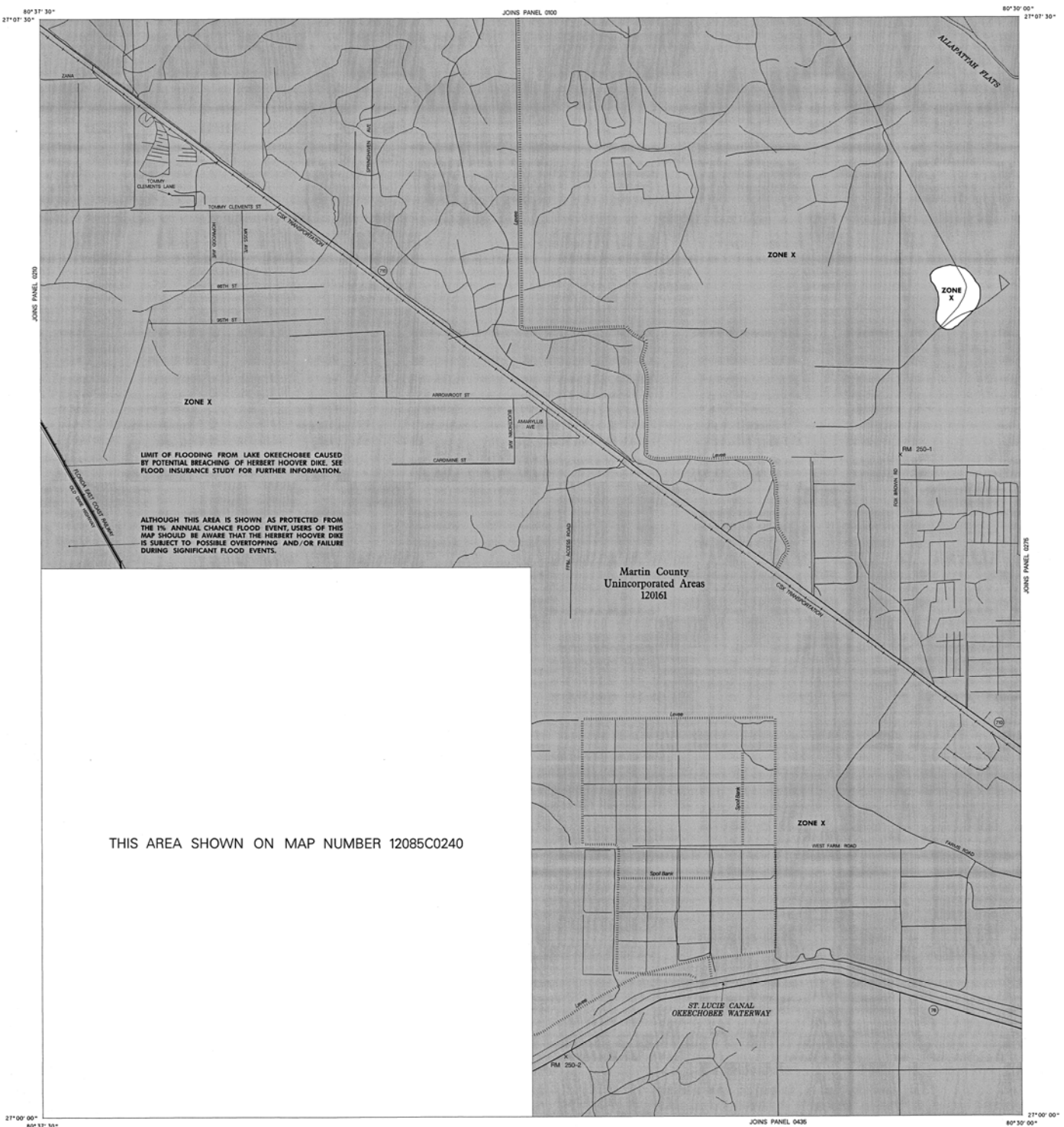

Elevations listed on this map were obtained from vertical control for determination of flood boundaries portrayed on this map. Users should be aware that elevations may have changed since the publication of the elevation information on National Geographic maps.
