I am working with the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on the environmental impact statement for the proposed Turkey Point Unit 6 and 7 reactors.

One of our tasks involves the preparation of the biological assessment document that is submitted to NMFS for review. I have been using your mapping website to determine the location of strandings and known nesting sites near Turkey Point, and it is very useful. One question I have is the time-frame represented in the GIS system. Specifically, does the stranding and nest information presented in the GIS represent data for this year, or by month?
