Purpose of call: DEIS Biological Assessment Status Report

Call notes: (bullets are acceptable)

- This phone call is a preliminary step to formal ESA Section 7 consultation.
- FPL and USACE have been working on ESA/Turkey Point issues for some time (couple of years).

- USFWS expects the following species to be addressed within the BA: Everglade snail kite, Florida panther, eastern indigo snake, wood stork, Florida manatee, American crocodile, sawfish.
- FPL will also address piping plover, sea turtles, and seaside sparrow.
- FPL will not directly address plant species, but will include discussion of them. Most listed plants occur in pine rocklands. Pine rocklands only occur in proposed transmission corridors.
- Kings Highway Rockland-a privately owned area already has a transmission line through it with 3-4 pads. New transmission may not need additional pads in this particular rockland.
- Guy line anchors may be needed in other rockland habitats.
