

**Triad Isotopes Response to**

**Request for Additional Information**

**Triad Isotopes - Warren, MI (CN584812)**

1. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> (and 8<sup>th</sup>) paragraphs of your letter dated 09/10/14, it indicates that the courier employer will furnish evidence of initial and recurrent training on an annual basis.

**Please confirm that Triad will maintain these records for inspection by the NRC.**

*Triad confirms that we will maintain copies of these records for inspection by the NRC.*

2. In the 3<sup>rd</sup> paragraph of your letter dated 09/10/14, it indicates that "Triad shall periodically inspect the courier vehicles..."

**Please clarify how often these inspections will be conducted by Triad and confirm that documentation will be maintained.**

*During each week in which contract vehicles are used, Triad will conduct random periodic inspections to ensure that blocking and bracing is utilized appropriately. Documentation will be maintained at the pharmacy location.*

3. In the 6<sup>th</sup> paragraph of your letter dated 09/10/14, it indicates that the courier employer will be responsible for providing dosimetry and monitoring dose if necessary.

**If dosimetry is provided, will Triad reserve the option to request dosimetry records for review and maintain said records for future NRC inspection?**

*Since the contract courier is responsible for determining the need for providing dosimetry and monitoring dose Triad will not request dosimetry records for review. Therefore all contract courier dosimetry records, as determined by the contract courier, will be maintained by the contract courier.*
