Dear Mr. Jensen:

On November 24, 2014, the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) completed a security baseline inspection at your St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2 and the NRC inspectors discussed the results of this inspection with Mr. Mark Fencil and other members of your staff. Inspectors documented the results of this inspection in the enclosed inspection report.

NRC inspectors documented two findings of very low security significance (Green) in this report. These findings involved violations of NRC requirements. The NRC is treating these violations as non-cited violations (NCV), consistent with Section 2.3.2.a, of the Enforcement Policy.

If you contest the violations or the significance of these NCVs, you should provide a response within 30 days of the date of this inspection report, with the basis for your denial, to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, ATTN: Document Control Desk, Washington DC 20555-0001; with copies to the Regional Administrator RII; the Director, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response (NSIR), and the Director, Office of Enforcement, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Washington, DC 20555-0001; and the NRC Resident Inspector at the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2.

If you disagree with a cross-cutting aspect assignment in this report, you should provide a response within 30 days of this inspection report, with the basis of your disagreement, to the Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response, the Regional Administrator, Region II, and the NRC Resident Inspector at the St. Lucie Nuclear Plant, Units 1 and 2.
