Enclosed is an application dated December 4, 2014, received by the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), from Mitsui & Co. (U.S.A.), Inc., requesting Amendment No. 3 to Export License XSNM3627/02. The license presently authorizes the export of 2,265 kilograms (kg) uranium-235 contained in 55,787 kg uranium, enriched to 4.95 WGT % maximum, as uranium dioxide (UO₂) for ultimate end use as reload fuel for Fukushima II, Unit Nos. 1-2, and Kashiwazaki-Kariwa, Unit Nos. 1-7.

The purpose of this amendment is to extend the proposed expiration date from February 28, 2015 to February 28, 2025, update the licensee's address, and change the licensee's point of contact.

There are no changes to the terms and conditions of the existing license being requested; therefore, our office is processing this as a minor amendment. The NRC intends to issue the license after the required 30-day review period.
