Dear Mr. Vickers:

By letters dated September 2, November 24, and November 26, 2014, and NRC Form 314 dated November 24, 2014, Parkersburg Cardiology Associates, Inc. submitted to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) a Request for Consent to direct License Transfer of activities and facilities conducted under NRC Materials License No. 47-25319-01. Based on the information you provided, we understand that as a result of a proposed sale of Parkersburg Cardiology Associates, Inc. to Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital Corporation, control of Parkersburg Cardiology Associates, Inc. facilities will be directly transferred to Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital Corporation. We further understand that this transfer will not result in any change to licensed material, persons using the licensed material, or location of use of licensed material. Finally, we understand that the Radiation Safety Officer from Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital Corporation will oversee the Radiation Safety Program in the facility previously operated by Parkersburg Cardiology Associates, Inc.

Based on the above understandings and as more fully detailed in the enclosed NRC staff's Safety Evaluation Report which documents the NRC staff's review of the request, we have no objection to the proposed transfer. We understand that the sale took place on September 8, 2014. Please find enclosed Amendment No. 8 terminating NRC License No. 47-25319-01 as requested by your letter and NRC Form 314 dated November 24, 2014. This action is being done concurrently with transferring your facilities and sources to the Camden-Clark Memorial Hospital Corporation License Number 47-09772-02 under Mail Control Number 584936. This termination is being issued in accordance with the requirements of the applicable NRC License Termination Rule (10 CFR 30.36).
