On December 10, 2014, the radiation source from an Electron Capture Detector (ECD) in a Perkin-Elmer 8500 Gas Chromatograph at Anheuser-Busch, LLC, One Busch Place in St. Louis, MO 63118 was removed by a representative of and transferred to R M Wester and Associates Inc, 215 Indacom Drive, St. Peters, MO 63376 for subsequent disposal. The source, serial number 4528, contained 15 mCi of Ni-63.

R. M. Wester and Associates, Inc. Radioactive Material License Number is 24-20091-01. The R. M. Wester and Associates, Inc. contact person in charge of this source is their R.S.O. Mr. Robert Wester.

The Perkin-Elmer 8500 Gas Chromatograph (serial number 610N9030906), containing no radioactive source, will be scrapped.
