**SUMMARY**

By application dated January 6, 2015, Columbiana Hi Tech, LLC, requested amendment of Certificate of Compliance (CoC) No. 9196, for the Model No. UX-30 package to allow Rev. 27 of the CoC to remain valid through February of 2016. The request included no changes to the safety bases for the CoC approval. NRC staff is issuing this revision to allow use of Revision No. 27 of the CoC until February 28, 2016. The staff finds the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71 is not affected.

**EVALUATION**

The requested amendment allows Rev. 27 of the CoC to remain valid through February of 2016. The request included no changes to the safety bases for the CoC approval. NRC staff is issuing this revision of the CoC to allow use of Revision No. 27 of the CoC until February 28, 2016, as previously requested in an October 2, 2014, application. The staff finds the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71 is not affected.

**CONDITIONS**

The following changes have been made to the certificate of compliance:

Section 3.b. was updated to include the application supplement dated January 6, 2015.

Condition No. 14 was updated to authorize use of Revision No. 27 of the certificate until February 28, 2016.

The References section was updated to include this request.

**CONCLUSION**

The staff finds the ability of the package to meet the requirements of 10 CFR Part 71 is not affected.
