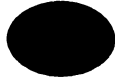

10. Radiation Safety Program

- The licensee possesses a radiation survey meter that meets the criteria in the section entitled "Radiation Safety Program Instruments" in NUREG-1556, Vol 1 Rev 1, 'Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses, ' dated November 21, 2001, in the event of an incident.
- Physical inventories will be conducted at intervals not to exceed 6 months, to account for all sealed sources and devices received and possessed in the license.
- The licensee will maintain, for inspection by NRC, documentation demonstrating that unmonitored individuals are not likely to receive, in one year, a radiation dose in excess of 10 percent of the allowable limits in 10 CFR Part 20.
- The licensee implements and maintains the operating procedures in Appendix H of NUREG-1556, Vol 1 Rev 1, 'Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses: Program-Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses, ' dated November 21, 2001, and provide a copy of these procedures to all gauge users at each job site.
- The licensee will perform Leak tests at intervals approved by NRC or an Agreement State and specified in the Sealed Source and Device Registration Sheet. Leak tests will be performed by an organization authorized by NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak testing services to other licensees or using a leak test kit supplied by an organization authorized by NRC or an Agreement State to provide leak test kits to other licensees and according to the kit supplier's instructions.
- For routine cleaning and lubrication the licensee implements and maintains procedures for routine of our gauges according to the manufacturer's recommendations and instructions.
- For non-routine maintenance or repairs the licensee will send the gauge to the manufacturer or other persons authorized by NRC or an Agreement State to perform non-routine maintenance or repair operations that require detaching the source rod from the gauge.
